



## NOTICE OF A SPECIAL (CALLED) MEETING OF THE PRESBYTERY OF EAST IOWA

At the request of the Presbytery Coordinating Commission, Co-Moderators TE Dan Jessop and TE Lori Wunder have called a **special meeting of the Presbytery of East Iowa for Wednesday, June 12, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. at the Eastdale Conference Room** (old Presbytery office at 1700 South First Avenue, Suite 23, Iowa City) for the purpose of acting upon the following time-sensitive items:

**MOTION: The Presbytery Trustees recommend that, in accord with Presbytery policy, the governing body approve the request from the Farmington, Sharon church to replace the aging elevator at an estimated cost of \$32,000 with funding from undesignated bequests and memorials.**

**Note:** This request requires Presbytery approval as the repair cost is more than 10% of the church’s annual budget. The Session approved this expenditure at their meeting on May 15, 2019. The timely replacement of this elevator is a necessity to serve the needs of the congregation.

**MOTION: The Presbytery Trustees recommend that, in accord with Presbytery policy, the governing body approve the request from the Davenport, Newcomb church to replace the HVAC system at an estimated cost of \$30,000 with funding to be taken from designated funds in the church budget.**

**Note:** This request requires Presbytery approval as the repair cost is more than 10% of the church’s annual budget. The timely replacement of this system is a necessity to serve the needs of the congregation.

**INFORMATION ITEMS**

**Hazleton:** The sale of the Hazleton property has been delayed a month and is now scheduled for the second week of June. The buyers were in a serious car accident, which is the cause of the delay. Jim Claypool has obtained a new abstract for the property and has forwarded it to the title company. He will draft the deed upon receipt of the title opinion and instruction concerning how the buyers want to accept title.
