WHO WAS JOHN D. McCANN

John D. McCann was a Presbyterian minister who served in East Iowa Presbytery for nearly two decades.

He moved to Iowa to become Director of Clinical Pastoral Education for the Alcohol Treatment Center at the University of Iowa.

He was a Certified Clinical Pastoral Education Supervisor as well as a Diplomat in the American Association of Pastoral Counselors.

In his counseling with people he combined the best of Pastoral Care with Jungian Psychotherapy. Through his private practice and the Iowa City Counseling Center he provided growth and healing for countless clients including many Presbyterians.

He served for many years on the Care of Candidates Committee and he continued as a valuable consultant after his committee term and retirement.

This Scholarship Fund was established in his memory in 1985.
